

Shelter Statistics 2020

January through December

Covid-19 completely altered program services. Safe Haven continues to provide all services, but in a different manner. Onsite shelter shut down from March 20 to June 1 and shelter was provided at hotels. Thousands of dollars of food boxes, hygiene bags, gas cards, diapers and other items are being distributed to participants to assist with their needs. No in person trainings or presentations have been allowed since March. Most volunteer activities and fundraisers have also been placed on hold.

The average stay was 16 days and all together 1,164 bed nights.



470 individuals (407 females and 63 males) made 1,301 crisis calls, 58 emails, and 82 texts.

Programs & Services

Support groups were attended by 37 women and 24 children.

Services were provided to 270 victims (198 women, 20 men, and 52 children).

96 volunteers logged 334 hours of service.

105 DV and 18 SA cases referred to the district attorney's office.

Presented to 14 classrooms grades K-12 educating 248 children.

Gave 1 community presentations to 13 people.

Provided 6 community awareness activities.

Provided 0 professional training to 0 people.
